The Refuge invites youth groups to bring their students for a weekend to SOW (Serve Others Well)! Students arrive Friday night to enjoy an evening gathering of singing, laughter and fun. For the weekend we create small groups for sharing and building new friendships. Teaming up with area ministries, mission teams will be sent on Saturday to a variety of serving opportunities. We will be the hands and feet of Christ in many different ways. That evening our groups return for another night of making memories that last a lifetime. Everything concludes on Sunday with a beautiful time of worship and thanksgiving for how God has used us to serve His people.

Our theme for Sow Rite 2017 comes from the three parables from Matthew 15 concerning "Seeds & Weeds".

• Friday Night Program -

"Sowing Good Seeds" - What makes "good seeds"? Where do we go to find "good seeds"?

• Saturday Night Program -

"Pulling the Weeds" - Learning to identify the weeds in our lives and the one who is planting them.

• Sunday Worship -

"Significant Seeds" - Every Godly seed (gifts) is significant no matter the size or worldly value.

The Refuge is located just outside of rural Ayden, NC. Our property includes a six acre pond, foot trails through undeveloped woodlands, athletic fields, a covered pavilion with basketball courts and five fully restored early 1900 farm houses.

The Refuge mission is to share and model the hope of Jesus Christ. We do this with our property, programs and people as we serve churches, youth groups, businesses, schools, and other organizations.
